Reach Developmental Preschool South Delta offers all children a stimulating, emergent curriculum to develop their physical, social, emotional, language, and cognitive skills to their full potential. Reach Preschool curriculum embraces the principles of the Provincial Early Learning Outcomes Framework and the Live 5-2-1-0 Program, and offers families an on-campus Parent Education Centre for a comprehensive early developmental education.

Our goal at Reach Developmental Preschool is to offer children a stimulating environment with opportunities for social, emotional, cognitive and creative development, emphasizing the individual child's awareness of his or her self, peers, family and society. We maintain a family centered approach to best address the needs of each individual child.



The Provincial Early Learning Outcome Framework:

Researched and developed by the Province of BC, this emergent curriculum starts with the children's interests.



The framework emphasizes providing children with rich experiences in 4 areas of learning to build a foundation for lifelong learning:

- Well-being and Belonging;
- Exploration and Creativity;
- Languages and Literacies
- Social Responsibility and Diversity

Your child's development and progress will be assessed throughout their preschool experience to help target learning outcomes and strengthen important kindergarten readiness skills.

LIVE 5-2-1-0: As your child's first school we share the responsibility to make environments healthier for your child and to help children make healthier choices as they grow.

Live 5-2-1-0 is an evidence-based message promoting four simple guidelines for raising healthy children:

- Enjoy FIVE or more vegetables and fruits everyday.
- Spend no more than TWO hours of screen time a day.
- Play actively at least ONE hour each day.
- Choose healthy with ZERO sugar-sweetened drinks.

Outdoor play, a school garden and nature exploration are a few ways in which the Reach Preschool builds 5-2-1-0 principles into learning.

Parent Education Centre: Reach Preschool supports whole family development with an on-campus centre where parents can find resources, learning materials and multi-disciplinary expertise from our child development experts. Further learning opportunities will be available through monthly Parent Workshops and helpful online resources that parents can read and download.
