








## Too Hot for Tots! Resource Description

The primary goal of this document is to provide educators with consistent, reliable, evidence-based information so they can teach caregivers how to reduce the risk of a burn injury in the home. The Handbook also shares ideas and best practice recommendations on how to effectively deliver this training in your community. The Too Hot for Tots! video disk is housed on the back page of the handbook.</p> <p><a href="#"><u><i>Too Hot for Tots! Video</i></u></a> uses the power of storytelling and re-enactments to show how easily thermal injuries can happen and how serious they can be. This set of 16 slides highlights the key messages from the videos and are to be shown as a review after caregivers have watched the <i>Too Hot for Tots!</i> and <i>Adjusting your Water Temperature</i> videos. The slides are designed to support group discussion which is a key factor in the success for the program.</p>
