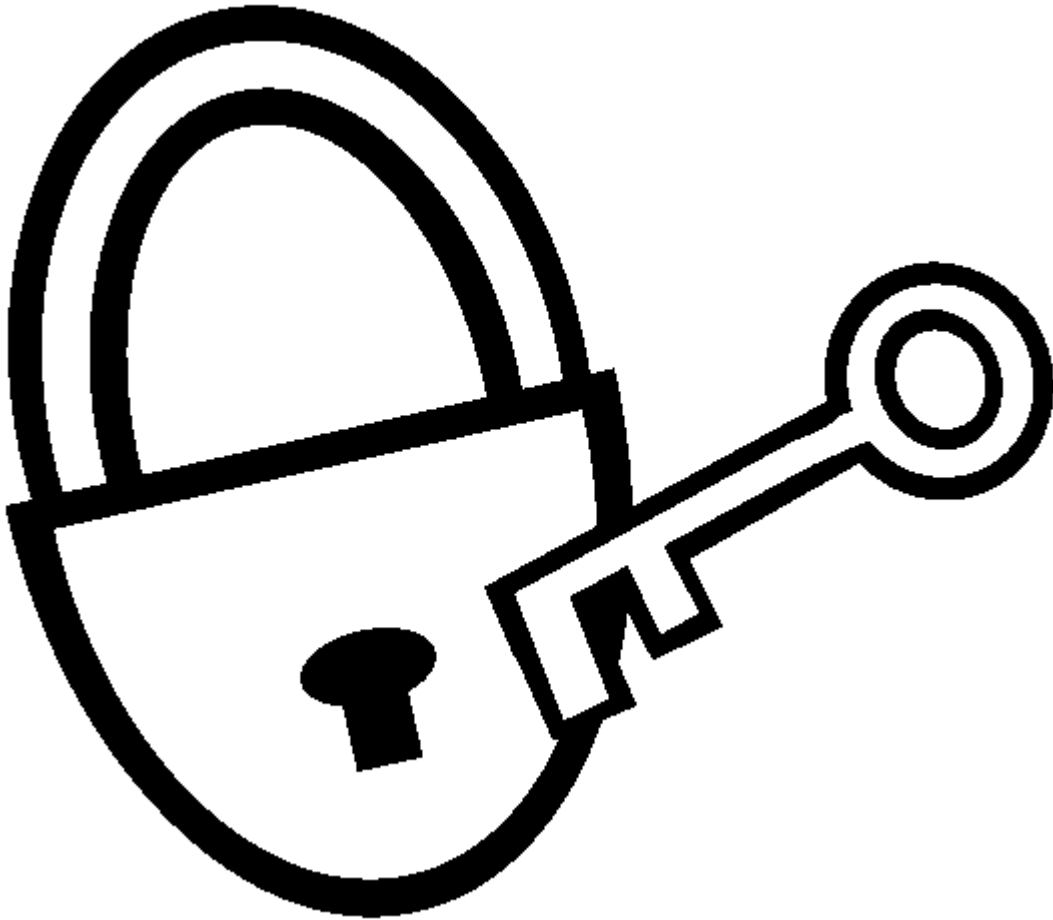

You can look at any information about you.



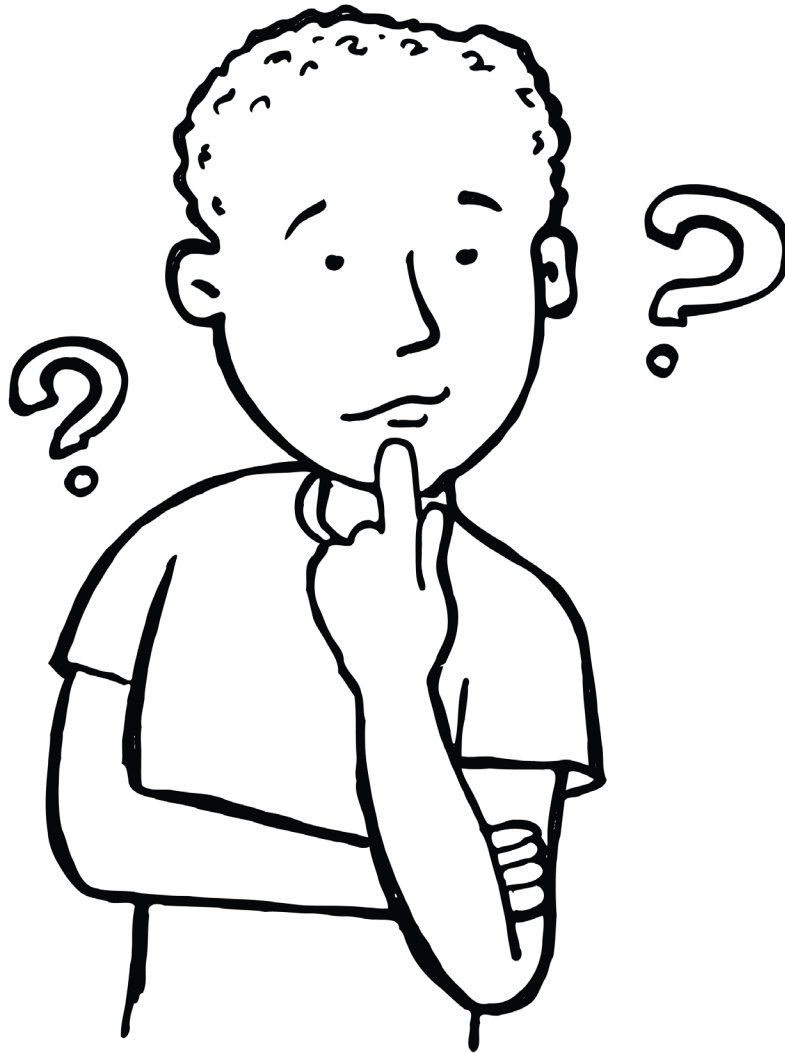
You have the right to have all your personal information protected.



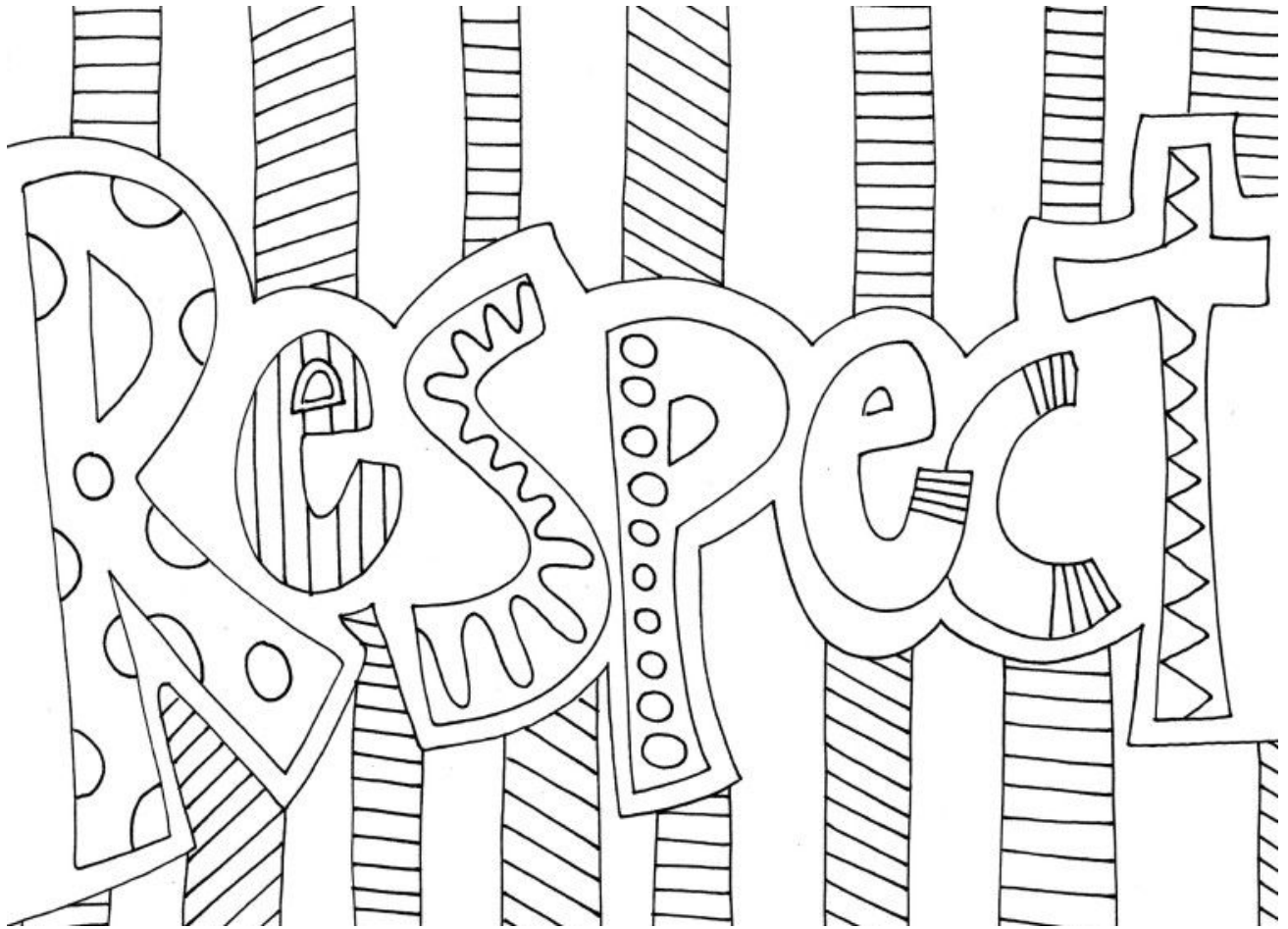
You can have a say in how we help you.



You have the right to ask questions and to have those questions answered.



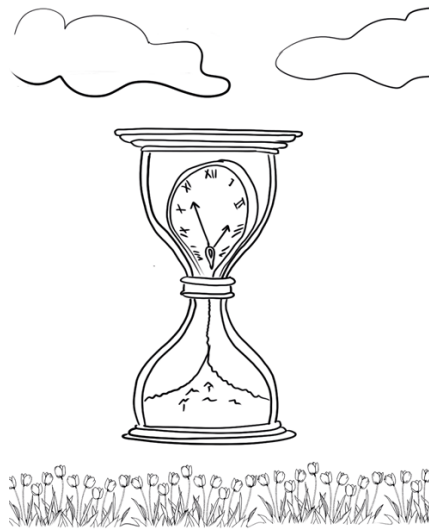
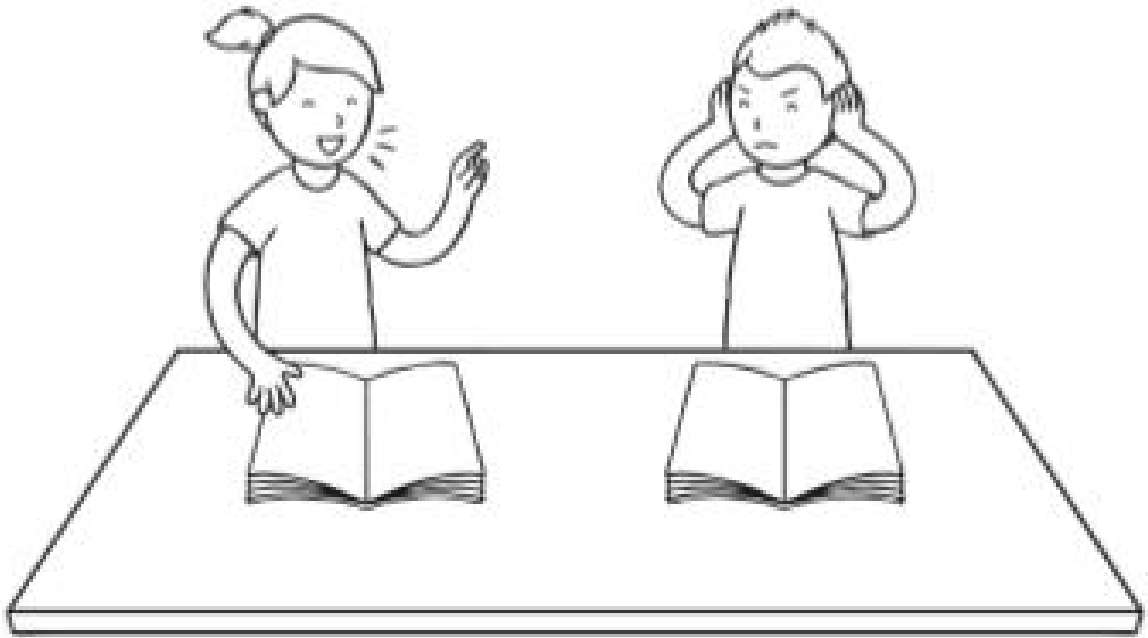
You have the right to be treated with respect and dignity at all times.



You have the right to have things explained in the way that works best for you.

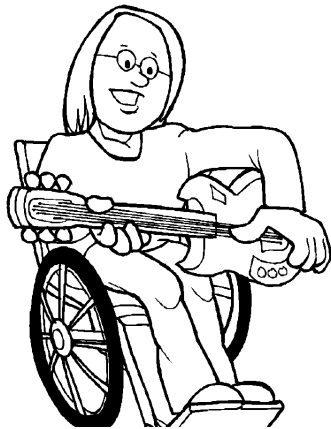


If you have any concerns or complaints, you have the right to have them sorted out in a fair way and in as short a time as possible.
