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Every child can reach their potential

Reach Child and Youth Development Society is a non-profit child development centre that has been working with children and families since 1959. Our programs and services are designed to meet a wide range of needs for children from birth to age 19, so that children at any age or stage of development have the opportunity to reach their full potential.

Infant Development Program providing in-home assessment and support for children from birth to age 3. Playgroups are offered in North and South Delta.

Reach ABA Program a highly structured, skill-building intervention program that uses Applied Behavioural Analysis principles to teach children with autism spectrum disorder the functional skills they need.

Reach Developmental Preschool in South Delta and North Delta provide inclusive settings for both children with typically developing needs, and children who require extra supports.

Supported Child Development providing consultative support to child care settings for children from birth to age 19 with special needs.

Aboriginal Supported Child Development providing consultative support to child care settings for children from birth to age 19 with special needs. ASCD programs are developed

with cultural values, beliefs and traditions in mind.

Therapies Program providing speech and language therapy, occupational therapy, and physiotherapy for children from birth to age 6.

Respite Care Program providing in-home, out-of-home, overnight, or group respite for children from birth to 19 with special needs.

GCT TEENS Social Group providing social skills and peer networking opportunities for teenagers with special needs in Delta & Surrey.

Delta Connex providing support to families with children birth to 19, who have developmental or behavioural conditions.

Positive Behavioural Support providing in-home support to families with children ages 3 to 19 who have special needs with challenging behaviours.

Positive Connections provides short-term service to families with children or youth with special needs with a focus on parent education, and connecting with community resources and support.

Choices IF providing behavioural support for families of children with special needs over the age of 6, consulting to group homes and other organizations and workshops to the community, fee for service.

Social Smart Club providing social skills and peer networking opportunities for children aged grade 1 to 12 with special needs.

Counselling providing consultation and counselling to families, individuals and children with a developmental diagnosis or delay.

New Parent Orientation helps families whose children have just received a diagnosis of ASD.

Referrals to Reach may come from you, the parent or caregiver, or from other sources such as doctors, public health nurses, school personnel, or other community professionals.
