
Reach Counselling Services Program

The Reach Counselling Services Program provides counselling and consultation for families, individuals and couples in Delta who have a child with a developmental diagnosis or delay. We also provide play therapy and counselling for children and youth, cognitive behaviour training and parent workshops.

Counselling for adults may address a variety of concerns ranging from marital stress to

depression to social anxiety. Services for young children up to age 12 may include therapeutic play and family therapy. Consultation on how to access other long-term resources is also provided.

Educational seminars are offered to parents and child care professionals on topics such as self-esteem, depression,



attachment, and anxiety.

The program is open to any family in Delta who has a child with a developmental disability, or any family that is already accessing one of our services.

Benefits of Counselling Services

At Reach we understand that having a child with a developmental disability, or having a disability yourself, can create extra stress. Talking with a counsellor can often be very helpful. A counsellor can create the opportunity for the client to review their options and gain new perspectives. Outcomes for children are more likely to be better when parents feel positive and are able to cope.

Referrals to Reach Counselling Services Program

Families who are receiving other Reach services can access counselling service through a staff contact person at Reach or by emailing or calling the contact number listed.

The Reach Counselling Services Program is neither a long term nor emergency service. If the situation is an emergency, the crisis line should be called at 604-951-8855. If it is anticipated that long-term intervention will be needed, other community resources will be provided.

Families in Delta with a child who has a developmental disability who are not receiving other Reach services can be referred by a professional from another agency in the community, or can self refer by contacting the Program Coordinator:
